Stations of Creation Walk Sunday 24th September at 2.00pm.

The Season of Creation starts on 1st September and ends on 4th October. It is an ecumenical celebration of prayer and action for the common home, and a time when we can celebrate everything in God's creation as well as reflect on the ways in which our lives may be damaging it. As the devastating impact of climate change is now a daily reality the celebration of the Season of Creation takes on even more importance.

One of the ways that we can celebrate the Season is by reflecting on the Creation narrative from the Book of Genesis as we observe nature's beauty. We will do this by visiting seven 'Stations' during a walk from the Cathedral Close to St George's Church at Harnham. We will meet at Mompesson House

in the Cathedral Close at 2.00pm and walk, via Elizabeth Gardens and the Harnham water meadows, to St George's Church at Harnham, pausing for a few minutes at our Stations. The walk is open to everyone; if you decide to join us we would be delighted to see you.
