Not much to write about this month; probably on account of the cold and the wet and various illnesses going around, so a short piece from me to fill some space and add some colour.

Salisbury, a city of 5 rivers

To the north, the Avon and the Bourne; the Avon flowing into the city centre and Bourne flowing into the Avon to the south east of the City. To the west, the Wylfe and the Nadder merge just outside Wilton before entering Salisbury as the Nadder and joining the Avon. Finally the Ebbel which joins the Avon to the South West of Salisbury. At Fordingbridge the Avon is joined by the Allen. As it heads it's way down to the coast it's constantly topped up by many minor brooks and streams, before finally joining the Stour just before it enters the sea in Christchurch Harbour. Interestingly the Avon, often know as either the Eastern Avon or Hampshire Avon, is often quoted as having two sources, one to the east of Devizes and one to the west of Pewsey.

With all the rain in early January there were flood alerts for much of the Avon from Salisbury down to the coast. Many of you would have seen the water in the various flood plains south of the city. To the west in Wilton we had flooding around both the Nadder & Wylfe.
