## Tony Broughton RIP

Salisbury Brother Antony Lawrence Rawlins Broughton died peacefully at home in Salisbury on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2026 following a short illness.

Tony was born in Newcastle on 25<sup>th</sup> June 1922. He served in the Royal Navy Volunteer Reserves (RNVR) for many years and remained on the Reservist List for 30 years, finishing as Lieutenant Commander. As part of his time in the RNVR he served on various vessels, including time in Malta during WW II on ELCO 70, Motor Torpedo Boats (HMS MTB 260 & 268) during the later part of WWII. Later he was awarded the RNVR Long Service Decoration (VRD). After leaving the Navy he worked at the Bank of England in London. On 13<sup>th</sup> March 1948 he married Lucy Astill in the town of Buckingham.

Tony was enrolled into Salisbury Circle on 25<sup>th</sup> May 1973. During this time he served as Secretary, Chamberlain and Charities



Officer.

His wife Lucy died in 2017 in Salisbury after 69 happy years of marriage and was much

missed by Tony. In his later years although, no longer able to attend meetings, he liked to keep in touch with what was happening in the Association and always maintained a keen interest in Circle activities.

Tony's funeral will be held on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> April at 10:00 in St Osmunds Church Salisbury.

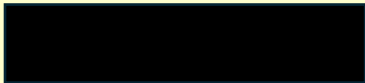
