40 years a Catenian

President of Salisbury Circle, Adrian Holloway, reached his milestone 40 years as a Catenian on 22nd January 2021. The plan put in place last year was that the GB National President, Eddie O'Donnell, would visit Salisbury for our Charter Night meeting in March when he would dine with us and present Adrian with his 40 year Scroll. Due to COVID it had to be a virtual presentation via Zoom. Director of Province 11, Roger Lillie, was also in attendance at the video meeting to offer his congratulations. Finally in July we managed our first live meeting, and Roger was able to present Adrian personally with his 40 year medal.

Born in March 1957, Adrian became a Catenian, when he joined Salisbury Circle in 1981 aged 23, one of the organisations youngest new members at the time; in those days you had to be over the age of 21 to join. Just over 3 years later in 1984 he became President of Salisbury Circle at the ripe old age of just 27. This was to be the first of 6 occasions where he has been Salisbury President. In 1987 he became Salisbury's Provincial Councillor, a post he held on 8 occasions. He has also served as President of Province 11 three times (first time in 1993 age 36, the youngest Provincial President at that time).

Although Adrian became a Catenian in January 1981 his association with Catenians goes much further back than that. His father John Holloway was a long serving Catenian, and in 1968, when his wife was unable to accompany him to the Catenian Conference at Torquay, Adrian joined him in her place, attending his first Conference aged only 11.

Although living in Bournemouth, joining Salisbury Circle was an obvious choice for Adrian. His father, John Holloway, who originally was a member of Bournemouth Circle, founded Salisbury Circle and was its first President, a position he held at Salisbury twice whilst remaining a joint member of Bournemouth Circle (where he also served as President several times). Later in life John was also a joint member of Exeter Circle where he also served as President. So for Adrian, with his father as founding President, Salisbury was the obviously choice, when he joined the Catenians. Adrian always considered Salisbury as "Dad's Circle". It is particularly appropriate therefore that Adrian will be President when Salisbury celebrate their 50th anniversary in March 2022.

At the age of 64, it's hopeful that with good health remaining and God willing we shall see him achieve his 50 year scroll. After that, well who knows?

Other News

A return to the White Hart as our dinning venue was very successful and the meeting and dinner were enjoyed by Salisbury Brothers & wives, our visitors and 3 Priests.

Easing of COVID restrictions has also meant a resumption of physical visits to other Circles and also the start of our Social Programme. Initially we have a Walk followed by lunch on Wednesday 11th August and another Pub Lunch on Wednesday the 8th September.
