Salisbury Brother Tony Broughton celebrated his 100th birthday on Saturday 25th June. Tony was enrolled into Salisbury Circle on 25th May 1973 and is our second longest serving Brother; over 49 years as a Salisbury Catenian.

During this time he served as Secretary, Chamberlain and Charities Officer. Although no longer able to attend meetings he likes to keep in touch and maintains a keen interest in Circle activities.

Tony served in the Royal Navy for many years and remained on the Reservist List for 30 years, finishing as Lieutenant Commander. As part of his Reservist duties he served on a Motor Torpedo Boat (MTB 260) during the later part of WWII. After leaving the Navy he worked at the Bank of England.

A Mass was said for him at St Osmunds Church on his birthday.
