John Say 29th November 1932 - 2nd October 2022 RIP

Salisbury Brothers were saddened to hear the news of the death of Brother John Say. John had been a Catenian since December 2007 and held the position of Circle Registrar in 2009 & 2010. Due to health reasons he had been unable to attend meetings in recent years, but he always welcomed visits from Salisbury Brothers and was able to meet up for the occasional lunch social, particularly at the Cathedral Refectory, which was a short wheel chair journey from his house in the Cathedral Close. A quietly spoken man, he had a sharp sense of humour, spoken with a smile and a twinkle in his eye. His funeral was held on 26th October at St Osmunds Church.
