Salisbury Brothers were saddened to hear the loss of Brother Simon on 18th September, aged 83.

Simon was enrolled in the Catenians at Salisbury on 26 January 1989. During that time he served in Office for 17 of his 32 years in the Circle. President in 1995 & 2000, Vice President 1994 & 1999, Membership 2003, Registrar 2011 to 2018, Marshall 1990 to 1993; a remarkable achievement.
