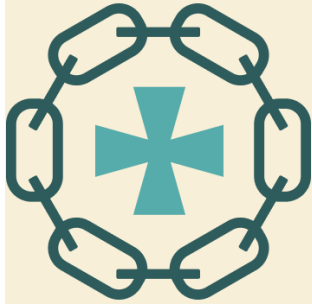

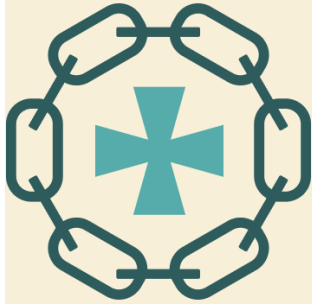


Bro. Eamon wearing the Hard Hat presented to him after our February meeting by Bro. Michael to hide his self inflicted "battle scarred" forehead.
