On Monday 22nd August last years President, Adrian Holloway, presented a cheque to the RNLI Selsey Bill lifeboat station for £2,200 raised by Salisbury Catenians.

Adrian was accompanied by a number of Catenians and their wives and families After a stop for lunch on the way down, the party had a private tour of the lifeboat station which included chats with the crew, an interior viewing of the lifeboat and an explanation of how the boat is launched and recovered.

It was Selsey Bill lifeboat Station that launched 2 boats to rescue Adrian and his crew when his boat ran aground on the Mixon Reef 1.25 miles off Selsey Bill durring a wet and stormy night on 1st November 2019. Unfortunately Adrian's boat was badly holed and sank after the rescue.
