

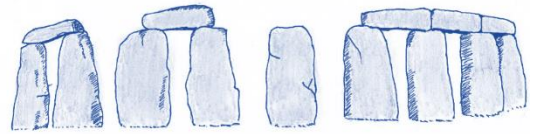

Our Annual General Meeting will be held immediately prior to the April circle meeting, at what will be the beginning of the new Catenian year.
