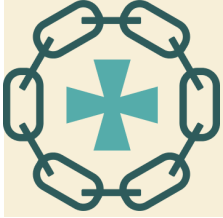

### Charter Night, Ladies Night

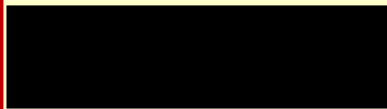
